

**CORUNNA LEGION BRANCH 447  
CHASE THE ACE (CTA) EVENT**

A Catch the Ace progressive raffle lottery is a multiple-draw game in which participants purchase tickets for a chance to win a percentage of the proceeds from the sale of tickets from one draw and also a chance to win a progressive jackpot.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. You must be at least 18 years of age to participate in this raffle event.
2. A standard deck of playing cards is shuffled and put into identical, opaque envelopes and sealed. These envelopes will be shuffled and randomly numbered from 1 to 52 and placed in a locked glass front case which will be on display during the raffle drawings.
3. Tickets are \$2 each and can only be purchased between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on designated Wednesdays beginning January 17, 2018.
4. Participants may purchase a maximum of 10 tickets per draw and can only purchase tickets once each week. Purchaser's hand will be stamped when tickets are purchased.
5. Purchasers must complete ticket stubs including first and last name, phone number and envelope number they choose if their ticket is drawn.
6. Ticket purchasers will be responsible to ensure that tickets are filled out completely. If envelope number has not been filled in the envelope with highest number remaining will be selected on their behalf.
7. Maximum participants will be limited by either the building capacity as set out in Liquor License or when all available tickets have been sold. Any tickets that were available for sale on a draw night and were not sold will not be available for purchase at any other date.
8. Tickets will be numbered in sequence from 0001 to 27500 and are unique from draw to draw. Tickets are only valid for the draw for which they are purchased.
9. 750 tickets will be available for purchase during the first 10 weeks followed by 1,000 tickets for the next 10 weeks, 1,400 for the next 5 weeks and 3,000 for the 26th week, during which the EXIT Strategy will be deployed.

**The event will conclude IF the ACE OF SPADES is drawn at any time.**

10. The weekly draw prize and the progressive Jackpot amounts will be announced prior to each draw.

11. Once money has been counted and recorded one (1) ticket stub will be randomly drawn from all tickets sold that evening.

12. The winning ticket holder as indicated on the ticket stub will receive the weekly prize amounting to 20% of that evening's ticket sales by cheque.

13. The envelope matching the number written on the winning ticket stub will be opened and the card removed. If the envelope number indicated on the winning ticket stub has already been selected, the ticket holder will be given the opportunity to revise their envelope number by drawing a single line through the envelope number as indicated and write in a new selection. (See #6 of these rules for envelope selection if this number has not been indicated on the winning stub).

14. If the selected envelope contains the ACE OF SPADES, the winner as named on the ticket stub will also be awarded the progressive jackpot by cheque. This will conclude the raffle.

15. If the selected envelope does not contain the ACE OF SPADES, the card will be destroyed and 30% of that evenings ticket sales will be rolled over to the progressive jackpot.

16. Ticket and envelope draws will be videotaped and retained for 30 days as set out in Lottery License.

EXIT Strategy:

a) If, after 25 weeks of play, the ACE OF SPADES has not been drawn the progressive jackpot will be awarded on the 26th week of the raffle.

b) The event will be held at the regular time and place.

c) The ticket holder as indicated on the stub of the first winning ticket drawn on week 26 will receive the weekly prize amounting to 20% of that week's ticket sales followed by opening of the envelope number written on the stub.

d) If the envelope number indicated on the winning ticket stub has already been selected, the ticket holder will be given the opportunity to revise their envelope number by drawing a single line through the envelope number as indicated and write in a new selection. (See #6 of these rules for envelope selection if this number has not been indicated on the winning stub).

e) The envelope matching the number written on the winning ticket stub will be opened and the card removed. If the card is revealed to be the ACE OF SPADES, the winner as named on the ticket stub will also be awarded the progressive jackpot by cheque. This will conclude the raffle.

f) If the card is not the ACE OF SPADES, this process will be continued until the ACE OF SPADES is revealed. The holder of any ticket stub drawn after the initial, winning draw on week 26 are not eligible to win the 20% weekly prize.

The Royal Canadian Legion Branch 447 reserves the right to publish a photo and/or name of winners each week on their face book page, website page and any and all local media outlets at their discretion.

The decision of the CTA Raffle Committee shall be final.

- ? Corunna Legion Branch 447 will close Nevada sales during CTA activities**
- ? Officials connected to the CTA raffle and sellers will not be eligible to participate**
- ? A separate bank account will be opened and maintained to manage CTA funds**
- ? Information on accessing the Gambling Hotline will be posted at facility, on tables, website, all advertising and both portions of tickets.**
- ? Records and reports will be provided/completed as per Lottery License stipulations**
- ? Draws to commence Wednesday January 17, 2018 and end July 11, 2018 or sooner when ACE OF SPADES is drawn.**
- ? Hall capacity 143 lounge and 295 hall**
- ? Parking lot capacity 100 vehicles plus on road parking**
- ? 24/7 security services present plus cameras for inside and parking areas.**
- ? The Royal Canadian Branch 447 will secure either a financial guarantee or letter of credit as required to guarantee payout of prizes.**
- ? All proceeds from ticket sales will be placed in locked safe immediately following close of ticket sales.**
- ? Three individuals will be assigned as security and safety personnel to handle issues .e fire.**
- ? A log, including signatures of those handling tickets, will be kept showing tickets available for sale, tickets sold and unsold tickets, including ticket serial numbers.**
